## **DO I NEED TO ENABLE CERTAIN BROWSER SETTINGS TO USE THIS WEBSITE?**

Our website requires the use of "stored cookies" and JavaScript to provide you with a feature-rich site. To achieve the best possible user experience when visiting our site, we recommend that you enable these settings.

## **DOES NOMADIC ROAD COLLECT PERSONAL INFORMATION ABOUT ME?**

NomadicRoad.com does not store any personal information that you provide when you interact with our site unless you fill out and submit a form from the NomadicRoad.com site. If you chose to fill out a NomadicRoad.com request form, we will 'remember you' by transferring a 'cookie' to your hard drive. This allows us to automatically fill out form information and present you with this information that you provided on an earlier visit. This personal information, such as name, address, phone number, and E-





mail information saves you the task of re-entering this information every time you request something from us by filling out a Web site Request Form. We do not collect any personal information without your knowledge and permission, nor do we sell or rent any site visit data to other parties. Until you, and if you, choose to "submit" a Web site Request Form, you will be assigned a temporary "session cookie" in order for us to keep track of your language and country selection as well as any personal information you have entered on one of our Web site request forms. If you do not "submit" this Web site request form, the Web site request form information is deleted when the "session cookie" is removed upon exiting ietravel.com Web site. Once you "submit" a Web site request form, we write a "cookie" with your information to "your" hard drive and remove this information from temporary storage. In order to do this ietravel.com requires cookies for language, country, and Request Form information and therefore we recommend that you leave cookies turned on while using our site.

#### **WHAT IS A COOKIE?**

Cookies are small non-executable data files written to your hard drive or memory. These data files contain information the site can use to track such things as data you have entered, lists of pages you've visited, and the date when you last looked at a certain page. Cookies cannot perform any function on your hard drive, they simply store small amounts of information that can be read by the site that originally stored the cookie. Browsers offer you the option to "Warn Before Accepting Cookies." This is turned off by default. If you turn it on, you will get a dialog box telling you a cookie is being used. Simply accept the cookie to move on.

#### **WHY DOES THE WEBSITE REQUIRE 'COOKIES' AND JAVASCRIPT?**

At the most simple level, NomadicRoad.com requires the use of "session cookies" to remember your request information between each page of the site so you do not have to re-enter this information if you choose to fill out another request form. Additionally, if you choose to fill out and "submit" any Web site request form, galapagosexpeditions.com will, "remember you" by transferring a "stored cookie" to your hard drive. This allows us to remember your request information and present you with pre-filled request forms upon subsequent Web site visits. JavaScript is used to enhance the experience even further. To enjoy the convenience of not having to fill out a request form with your name, address, phone number, and E-mail details each time you visit the site, you must make sure your browser is set up to accept cookies.
